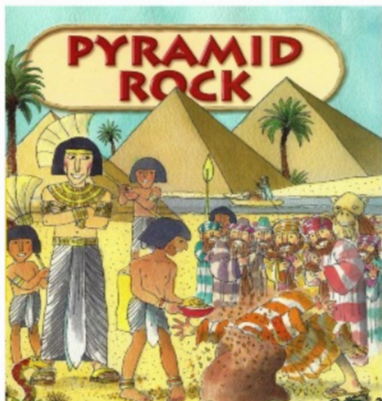
Car Lifts to Church
